



We take time to remember this each year.

Now upon the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain others with them. 2 And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre. 3 And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments: 5 And as they were afraid, and bowed down their faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead? 6 He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee, 7 Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again. 8 And they remembered his words, 9 And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest. 10 It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary the mother of James, and other women that were with them, which told these things unto the apostles. 11 And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they believed them not. 12 Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in him-

self at that which was come to pass.

Do we understand the significance?

24 But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; 25 Who was delivered for our offences, and was **raised again for our justification**. Romans 4:24-25

We celebrate the sacrifice of Jesus and the resurrection of Jesus because He accomplished for us what we could never accomplish on our own. He satisfied the wrath of God, paid the debt of our sin, and God accepted His offering on our behalf: acknowledged by the resurrection.

God's acceptance of the Jesus' perfect sacrifice is our joy. We praise our Lord and Savior for making a way for us to be reconciled to the Father. We actually remember this week after week as we attend worship services on the first day of the week.

This is not Easter, it is resurrection day, the day of our justification, the day of the Lord.
